THEY THINK IT'S ALL OVER... IT IS NOW

By the time you read this, the country may well be in the grip of World Cup fever. Having defeated Tunisia in their opening match last night (I am writing this on the 19th June), the England football team could well have qualified for the knock-out stages of the competition after further victories - or at least draws - in their next two group games. Who knows... but a semi-final, the final, and even the winner's podium may still be within their grasp. Then again, they may by now have blown their chances, as so often in the past, with sub-standard performances and disappointing results against Belgium and Panama: fifty-two "years of hurt," and counting?

At the risk of alienating 98% of the parish, I must confess that, when it came to international football, I was raised by my Scottish father to support not one but **two** teams: Scotland, of course - but also whoever happened to be playing **against** England. One of my earliest sporting memories, in fact, is of England's disastrous defeat to Poland in 1973, which meant failure even to qualify for the following year's World Cup Finals. The tournament losses to Argentina (1986) and West Germany (1990) were also particular occasions for *Schadenfreude* on my part. Naturally, I couldn't condone Maradona's cheating "hand-of-God" goal; but let's just say that when Gazza cried, I didn't... *

Anyway, a major international sporting festival, such as the World Cup or the Olympic Games, always puts me in mind of Heaven. While some people might imagine Heaven to be a place of almost oppressive calm, like some dull and hushed celestial library, the Bible reveals it to be a gloriously noisy, energetic mass of humanity - like a nation of sports fans celebrating their team's victory on the pitch or on the track (think: Super Saturday at London 2012). But better even than just one nation coming together for a short time, the Bible actually depicts Heaven as a never-ending, **world-wide** affair – with people from **every** country standing side-by-side, singing together in celebration of an undisputed World Champion, whose greatest victory was won not on a pitch or on the track, but on a cross and in the tomb.

Now, because He is the *World* Champion, who died for the sins of the *world*, Heaven will be wonderfully free from the social, political and racial tensions that have marred our common life throughout history. And since there will be no place in Heaven for any anti-English sentiment (however pathetic or trivial), I clearly need to get down to some training: so "Come on Harry Kane!" "Come on England!"

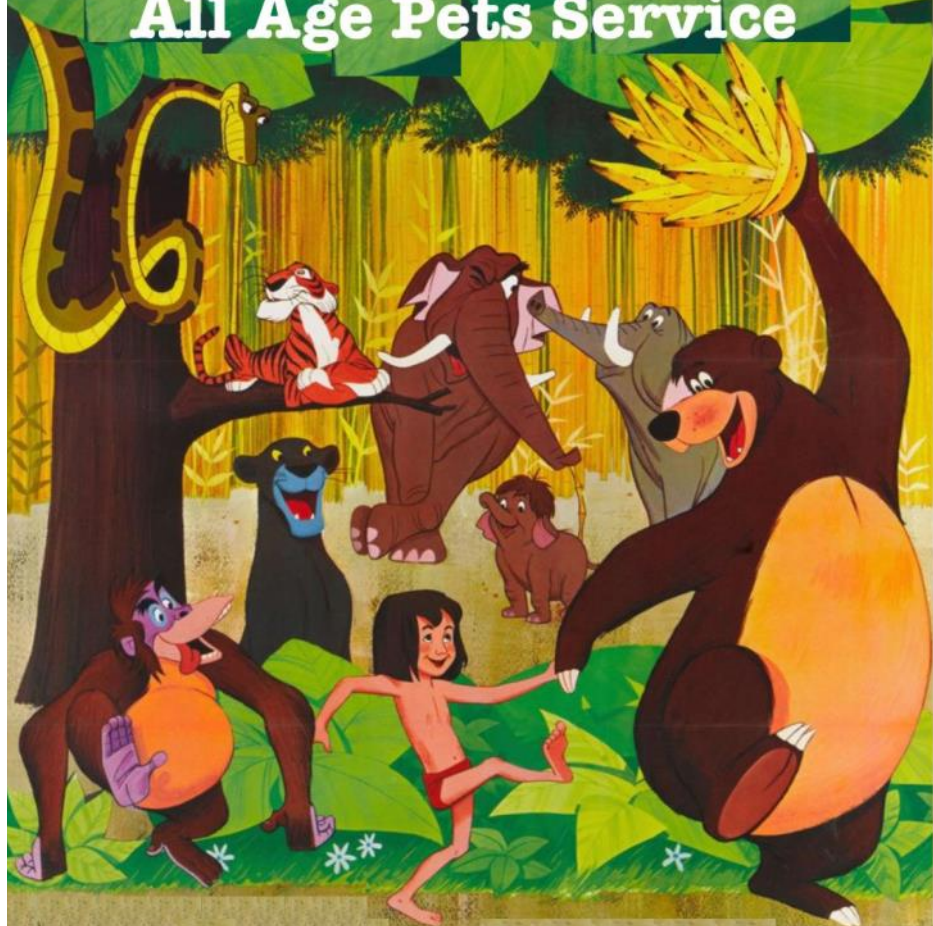
