#### Now we're the Parish of Appleton with Besselsleigh!

It is with a certain sadness that, as a resident of Besselsleigh, I write to explain about the dissolving of the Parish of Besselsleigh. However it is with personal pleasure that I find that the part of the Parish which lies to the North West of the A420, and which includes both the Church of St Lawrence and the Village of Besselsleigh, has been united with Appleton and is now to be known as the Benefice (or Parish) of Appleton with Besselsleigh.

A few years ago, due to ever increasing financial pressures and the very small size of the congregation, the Diocese, in discussion with the PCC of St Lawrence Besselsleigh, took the decision to close the Church of St Lawrence and dissolve the Benefice of Besselsleigh. This act finally took place on 28<sup>th</sup> March this year and the Parish was duly divided between Appleton, Dry Sandford and Cumnor. (Historians might be interested to note that in 1936 the Benefice of Besselsleigh was united with Dry Sandford, only to be severed from Dry Sandford in 1985, at which point it was united with Appleton).

In agreement with the Diocese, the villagers of Besselsleigh have formed a Trust - The St Lawrence Besselsleigh Trust - which has taken a 99 year lease from the Diocese, in order to maintain and repair the Church as required. Over the years, bequests have been made which should provide sufficient funds for this purpose. These funds are largely held by a charity, The Friends of Friendless Churches, with the income being passed on annually -previously to the PCC and now to the Trustees, for the restricted purpose of the repair and maintenance of the Church and Churchyard. Although the Churchyard, which will remain open, now officially becomes the responsibility of the Appleton with Besselsleigh PCC, the Trustees have agreed, with the monies available to them from the income, to continue to undertake the maintenance of the Churchyard as well as the Church.

The St Lawrence Besselsleigh Trust has three Trustees, one appointed by Appleton with Besselsleigh PCC, one appointed by Besselsleigh Parish Council and one appointed by the Friends of Besselsleigh. The founding trustees are Carol Dodimead (PCC), Jane Cranston (Besselsleigh Parish Council) and James Binning (Friends). James's family have farmed the land opposite the church for many years and his grandparents are buried in the Churchyard.

Under the terms of the Trust, up to six church services a year may be held at St Lawrence, Besselsleigh and I much hope that local people from the new Benefice and surrounding area will from time to time visit the lovely old Church of St Lawrence to worship there.
