Appleton with Eaton History Group The summer's big dig

Appleton's big archaeological dig on Broadmoor Field provided more evidence that a community had lived there over a long period of time during the Iron Ages. Post holes marked a livestock barrier or maybe a meeting place at the highest point of the field. Enclosure ditches were filled in and later cut into by the drip gully that surrounded a newly built roundhouse. Nearby, there were midden pits, and pits containing charcoal and ash mixed with clay and grease which may have been used for cooking, storing food or metal working.

Data, drawings and sections are now to be analysed, finds such as animal bones and pottery will be washed, identified and dated, and soil samples will be filtered for pollens, seeds, and other biological detritus. All will help build a picture of Appleton life around 2,000 years ago.

A very big thank you goes to the Dick and Farrant families for their enthusiastic support of the excavation, the Ulfhrafnar Viking reenactors for coming to bring the excavation to life, and to Dr Jane Harrison and the team of volunteers, students and Appleton villagers who made it all possible.
