<b>21/5</b>	<b>Matters Arising</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• JA reported he has been in discussions about the bench at the sportsfield.</li><li>• AL reported the defibrillator has been installed and is registered with the ambulance service.</li><li>• The table tennis table was discussed during agenda item 21/7.</li><li>• JA will speak to AH Cornish about the ploughing of the field next to Jubilee Park in future.</li><li>• RG reported that the grass cutting at the sportsfield is going well.</li><li>• AL reported she has had a few responses about the fitness equipment moving to the sportsfield. JA will ask RH about how difficult it would be to move the remaining 2 pieces of equipment</li><li>• AL will put a notice in the Advertiser about the need to remove the equipment, the cost to remove the equipment is high and the use doesn't justify the cost based on the response received. She will also ask if anyone would like to have these pieces of equipment.</li><li>• RG reported that some metal has been removed from the sportsfield, but that some remains. The Committee agreed to leave the extra bits there at the moment.</li><li>• NW reported that he will send an invoice to the Cricket Club from last year and for this year.</li></ul>

She will advise of the new representative once one has been established.</li> <li>• Table Tennis Table: The Committee discussed the replacement table and resolved to purchase a sturdier table for £1750. The amount which has been recovered from the insurance company is £625 and there is a reserve from the table tennis grant of £280.56 leaving a difference of £844.44</li> <li>• Event for August Bank Holiday: SW reported that monies raised at the event for the August Bank Holiday will go towards new play equipment for young children.</li> </ul>
