

TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT. 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

LOCATION: Tubney, A420 NB & SB; A338 Rbt (A420, between the A415 Kingston Bagpuize

Rbt and the A338 Rbt in both directions.

A420, between the A338 Rbt and the B4017 Cumnor Interchange in both

directions)

REASON: To facilitate the resurfacing of the carriageway and subsequent

reinstatement of all lines and road markings.

DURATION: Starting on 21 August 2025

The anticipated completion date is 23 August 2025 (date included). This will operate between 20:00 and 06:00 x2 Overnight closures. Road to be

re-opened between consecutive shifts.

(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and

for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress

of the works

The "No Waiting" restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow "No Waiting" cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Eastbound traffic wishing to use the A420 from the

Kingston Bagpuize Rbt will be diverted south and east along the A415 Abingdon Road to Frilford, to turn back north on the A338 returning to

the A420 at Tubney, and vice versa.

Eastbound traffic wishing to use the A420 from the A338 Tubney Rbt will be diverted south on the A338 to Frilford, to continue east along the A415 to the Marcham Interchange, to turn north up the A34 trunk road as far as the Botley Interchange, returning back to the A420, and vice versa.
